Our Torah reading has Abram leaving his country; problems wherever he goes; visit from Melchizedek; birth of Ishmael; and the command to circumcise. The Haftarah reading has ADONAI comforting His people and a promise to help. Our Brit Chadashah reading speaks of circumcision, salvation, and faith.
