

**Parashat Ki Tetze - כי תצא - "When you go out"**

Torah ~ *Deut. 21:10-25:19* | Haftarah ~ *Isa. 54:1-10* | Brit Chadashah ~ *Mt. 27:35-50; Jn. 3:13-17; Gal. 3:13-14*

Ki Tetze is the forty-ninth reading from the Torah and the sixth reading from the book of Devarim (Deuteronomy). In this week's portion we find 74 of the 613 commandments in the Torah, far more commandments than in any other single portion.

*John 4:22* ~ Most Christians are like the Samaritan's

*Hosea 4:6* ~ Lack of knowledge

*Isaiah 5:13* ~ Gone into captivity

*Deuteronomy 21:18-21* ~ Rebellious children

*Proverbs 13:24* ~ Sparing the rod

*Proverbs 19:18* ~ "Discipline your children while there is hope otherwise you will ruin their lives." NLT

*Deuteronomy 21:22-23* ~ Cursed is everyone who hangs on a tree

*Gal. 3:13* ~ Christ has redeemed us from the curse of the law, having become a curse for us for it is written, "Cursed is everyone who hangs on a tree" NKJV

*Numbers 21:5-9* ~ The Bronze Serpent

*John 3:14* ~ "And as Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness, even so must the Son of Man be lifted up" NKJV  
The Hebrew word used in *Num. 21:8* for pole is "Nes", which also means "banner or miracle."

It was a "miracle" that the Israelites would be physically healed and spared from death when they looked at a serpent (which is a picture of the curse from sin) lifted upon a pole. Yeshua's crucifixion on the cross (banner) not only saves us from spiritual death and separation from God when we look upon Him as our Lord, but it also gives us the opportunity to receive healing. How is all this possible? It is a miracle (Nes) from God.

*Isaiah 53:5* ~ "by His stripes we are healed" NKJV

*Num. 21:7* ~ But don't forget what the Israelites had to do first before they were healed and spared from death. REPENT

*Deuteronomy 22:12* ~ Tassels on Garments

*Numbers 15:37-41* ~ Wearing tzitzit reminds us God's promises in the Torah.

In English, the corner's of a Tallit is translated as "border". But a better translation from the Hebrew is "wings."

*Malachi 4:2* ~ "The Sun of Righteousness shall arise with healing in His wings" NKJV

*Luke 8:43-48* ~ A woman is healed by taking hold of Yeshua's tzitzit.

In closing ~ Let us raise our children according to the word of God, teaching them to repent of our sins and look upon Yeshua, Who was crucified for our salvation and for our healing.

**Aliyah to the Torah**

**Deuteronomy 21:22-23 NKJV**

- 22** “If a man has committed a sin deserving of death, and he is put to death, and you hang him on a tree,  
**23** his body shall not remain overnight on the tree, but you shall surely bury him that day, so that you do not defile the land which the Lord your God is giving you *as* an inheritance; for he who is hanged *is* accursed of God.

**Isaiah 54:4-5 NKJV**

- 4** “Do not fear, for you will not be ashamed; Neither be disgraced, for you will not be put to shame; For you will forget the shame of your youth, And will not remember the reproach of your widowhood anymore.  
**5** For your Maker *is* your husband, The Lord of hosts *is* His name; And your Redeemer *is* the Holy One of Israel; He is called the God of the whole earth.

**John 3:13-15 NKJV**

- 13** No one has ascended to heaven but He who came down from heaven, *that is*, the Son of Man who is in heaven.  
**14** And as Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness, even so must the Son of Man be lifted up,  
**15** that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have eternal life.
