Yom Teruah (יום תרוה) "Day Of Trumpets" Rosh Hashanah (ראש השנה) "Head Of The Year"

Torah ~ Leviticus 23:23-25; Numbers 29:1-6 Haftarah ~ Psalms 98:4-6; Nehemiah 8:1-3 Brit Chadashah ~ 1 Thessalonians 4:13-18; Revelation 11:15-19

Portion Summary:

In our Torah readings we have the Feast Of Trumpets, Yom Teruah, a day of sounding the Shofar. Due to other reasons in the Torah this Feast is also known as Rosh Hashanah, Head Of The Year. It is the first of the High Holidays, celebrated ten days before Yom Kippur. Rosh Hashanah is observed on the first two days of Tishri, the seventh month of the Hebrew calendar. In the Haftarah we see praising ADONAI by blasting the Shofar; and reading the Torah in the Seventh month. The Brit Chadashah readings speak of the Rapture; and Yeshua's second coming.
